Major and minor scales
*Appropriate for each player's ability
and instrument*

Prepared pieces
*Be prepared to play at least
portions of two different works --
one in a fast tempo and the other
slower -- that together show "what
you can do." (Concerto, etude,
ensemble part, etc.) You won't be
asked to play for longer than a total
of five minutes.*

Sight Reading

Intonation Test
*You will be asked to match a pitch
played and identified for you.
No guessing involved.*
