Major and minor scales
Appropriate for each player's ability
and instrument

Prepared pieces
Be prepared to play at least
portions of two different works --
one in a fast tempo and the other
slower -- that together show "what
you can do." (Concerto, etude,
ensemble part, etc.) You won't be
asked to play for longer than a total
of five minutes.

Sight Reading

Intonation Test
You will be asked to match a pitch
played and identified for you.
No guessing involved.
